

Coordination, collaboration and synergies between national and regional EU and non-EU public research and innovation (R&I) funding programmes.

Secure the sustainable and responsible industrial supply of raw materials to strengthen the industry competitiveness and the shift to a circular economy.

Reduce the fragmentation of R&I funding across Europe and globally through the implementation of 3 Joint Calls for transnational R&I proposals.

ERA-MIN joint calls will scope is needs-driven R&I in exploration, extraction, processing, recycling and substitution of raw materials covering the whole innovation chain.

ERA-MIN joint calls will support partnerships between academia, industry, SMEs, NGOs and public authorities, to provide them access to leading knowledge and new markets across Europe and worldwide.

Open 2018 and 2019 joint calls to participation of funding organisations from countries and regions across the world.





SCOPE

Demand-driven research and innovation on primary and secondary resources of construction, industrial and metallic minerals and substitution of Critical Raw Materials, addressing one or several areas of the circular economy

€15 million (sum of national/regional funds and EU contribution)
