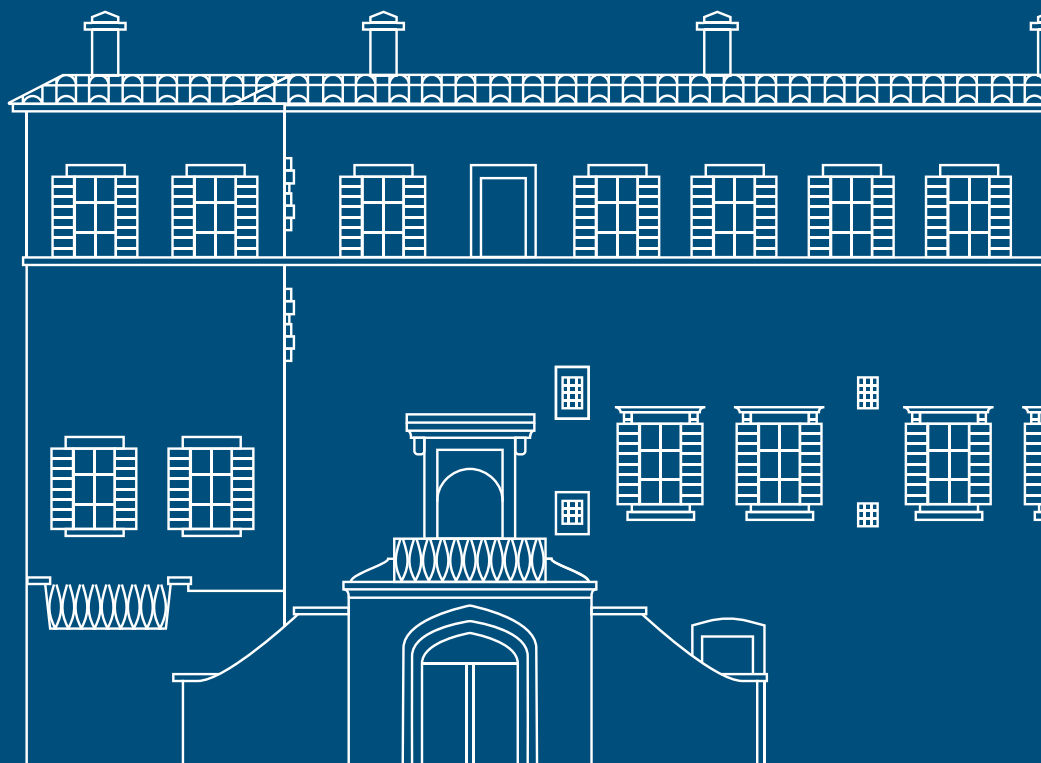

The Doctoral Programme in Economics (ECO) supports and trains the **next generation of researchers in economics**.

The offerings of our department include a Master of Research in Economics (MRes) and a doctoral programme.

Research topics studied by faculty and researchers in the department cover a **wide range of subjects** within the fields of microeconomics, macroeconomics, and econometrics, using both **theoretical and empirical approaches**.

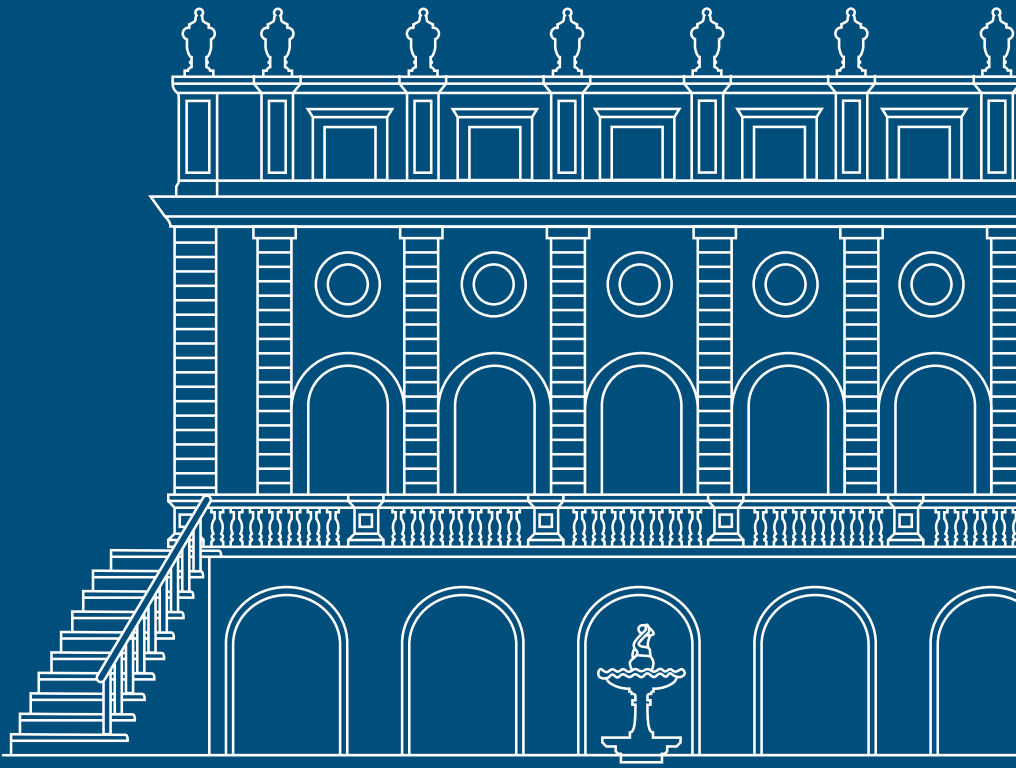

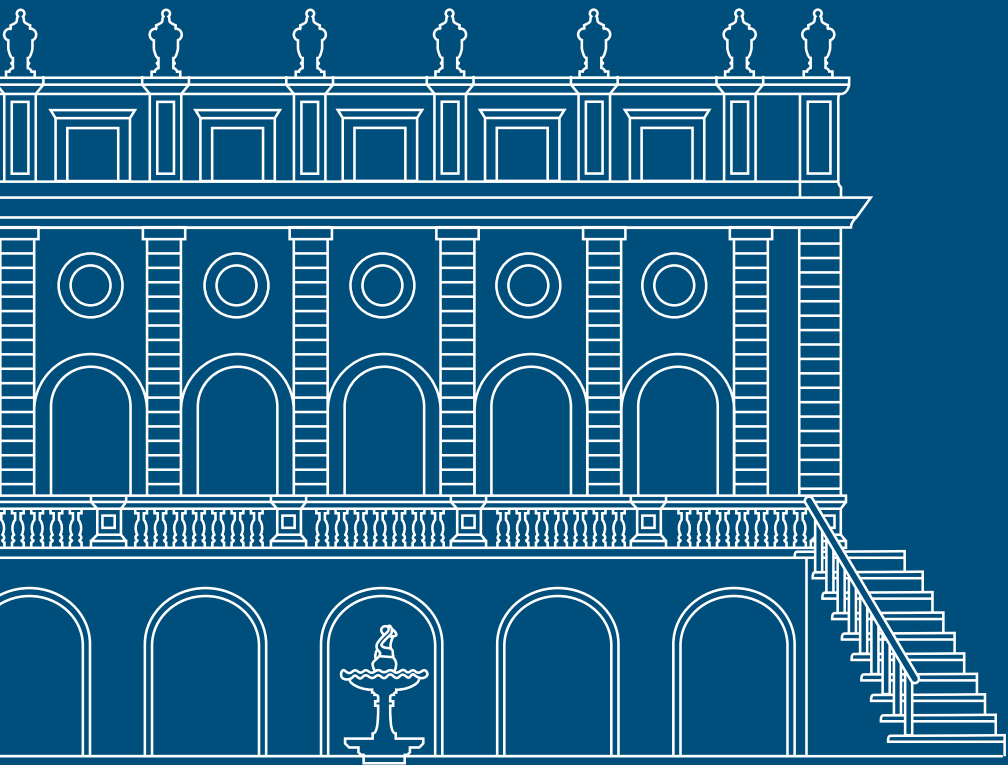

The EUI offers a unique environment where multidisciplinary collaboration is central. Our PhD programmes empower researchers to address pressing social challenges by combining diverse perspectives and expertise. Training is structured and comprehensive: the Academic Service and departments offer **dozens of seminars, workshops, and training sessions each year**, ranging from research design and data analysis to academic publishing, teaching practice, and professional skills.

SOCIAL IMPACT BEYOND ACADEMIA

At the EUI, research extends far beyond academic circles. Our doctoral researchers actively engage with European institutions, international organisations, NGOs, and civil society actors. Alumni trajectories reflect this outward-facing mission: more than **90% of PhD and LLM holders graduating between 2016 and 2020 were employed within 18 months**. Of these, around **65% work in academia**, while many others hold key positions in EU institutions, central banks, international organisations, and think tanks.
